This week in skills, the students will learn about CVC words with short /a/, create new rhyming words by changing the first sound, and change a phoneme in a one syllable word to make a new word. For content, they will use the text, *What's Alive*, to learn what makes something living and what living things need. For module, they will learn about parent and baby animals, have an LE Outreach at the school with the Zoo, and go on a living and nonliving scavenger hunt. For math, they will continue to compare groups of objects and numbers within 10 to determine greater, less, and equal, assess comparing numbers and begin to learn about 3D shapes.
