Overview of our week:

This week we will learn about land animals. We will learn about the characteristics land animals have that help them live in their habitats (mainly animals who live in or around TN). We will watch a Wild Kratts episode that talks about many animals who rely on trees for their safety, food, and shelter. We will also read books that explain the characteristics animals have that help them survive. At the end of the week we will do a couple of fun activities to help us learn about nocturnal animals as well as animals who hibernate.

During literacy block we will continue to discuss lowercase letters (their names, if they are tall or small, and how we write them); practice hearing beginning sounds in words; make lowercase letters with play dough; and draw a picture while focusing on details, characters, and the setting. During math we will continue to develop our subtraction skills by solving subtraction stories using our fingers and other physical objects.

During centers we will practice writing numbers 1-10, matching capital and lowercase letters, listen to The Kissing Hand, and play with play dough.

Now that it is warming up outside, you may want to send a light jacket/sweatshirt for your child to keep at school. The classroom stays pretty chilly.
